CHILDREN'S SERVICES

Mentor or tutor a foster care youth. (Foster Care) – Do you have a heart for youth? Are you looking for a volunteer opportunity on weeknights or weekends? Help a foster care youth build social skills and friendship by participating in community activities and common interests. If tutoring is needed, volunteers can assist with school subjects such as math and English. Volunteers needed in Richmond, Henrico, and Chesterfield on weekday afternoons/evenings and weekends. There is also a current need for bilingual (Spanish speaking) volunteers, but not required. [Off site, evenings and weekends]

Prepare baby donations for women in the community. (Pregnancy Counseling) – Many women are in need of clothes, diapers, and wipes for their new little one(s). Help CCC's Baby Closet meet client needs by organizing and preparing donations of baby clothes, diapers, and other baby supplies; returning calls and replying to other requests for baby items; assembling bags clients; and entering information into a database. The Baby Closet needs volunteers on Mondays and Wednesdays from 9:30am – 1pm. [On site, weekday mornings]

RESETTLEMENT SERVICES

Provide resources and support to newly arrived refugees. (Resettlement Services) – Work alongside CCC's resettlement case workers by referring refugees to community resources, training clients to use public transportation to get to appointments, setting up a refugee's new apartment, helping with school enrollment, and providing cultural orientation support. Let us know what area(s) interests you the most! All opportunities take place during normal business hours. [On site, weekdays]

Help a refugee prepare for a job interview. (Resettlement Services) – CCC helps refugees on the path to self-sufficiency by connecting them with local employers. You can help by assisting clients with job related English language skills, mock interviews, job application completion, resume development, job search techniques, and basic computer training. [On site, weekdays]

COUNSELING SERVICES

Provide empowerment as a mentor. (Counseling Services) – CCC assists people who have been the victim of a crime by connecting them with a mentor volunteer. Mentor Volunteers create trusting relationships with participants to promote attitudes of empowerment and healthy self-esteem. Volunteers meet in the home or community settings with the participants 1-2 times per month for six months. Training and on-going supervision is provided by licensed therapist. Mileage reimbursement is available. [Off site, evenings and weekends]
