FACTS ABOUT NATURALIZATION

- The Citizenship Exam has 4 parts: the Civics test, the speaking test, the reading test, and the writing test.
- To apply for Citizenship, you have to fill out a form called the N-400. Filing these papers costs \$680 that are payable to the United States Citizen and Immigration Services (USCIS.) Some applicants may qualify to not pay this fee. CCC has B.I.A. accredited Immigration Counselors who can help you with the N-400 application.
- You have to wait at least three months to take the test after you mail your N-400 application.
- Students who live in Newport News, Roanoke, and Richmond take their exam at the USCIS office in Norfolk.
